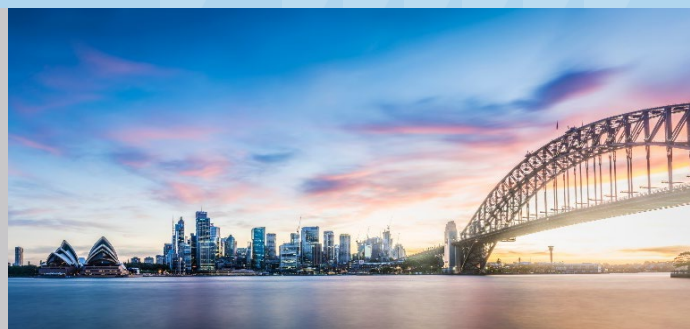


# Implant Dentistry from Single Tooth to Full-Arch
